1. Climate change

What is it?

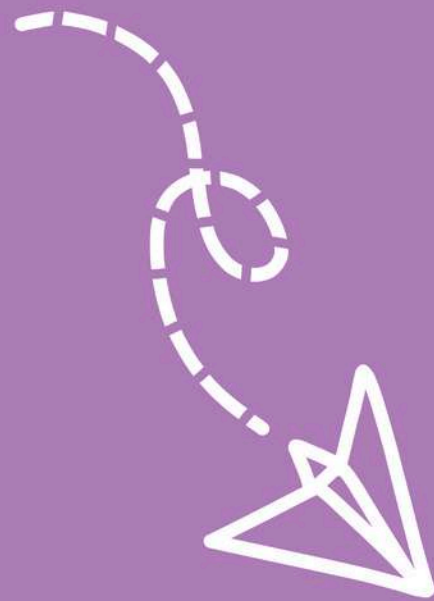


Climate change is a long term of the elements of climate spinning off that could continue for years, decades or even centuries.

Climate change in Italy

Italy is one of the countries with the biggest risk of affecting climate changes that could lead to a lot of consequences.



Without any urgent action, Italy will see a 35% increase in the frequency of agricultural drought by 2050. Heatwaves will last 1461% longer and the combination of sea level rise all of those factors will cause chaos for Italy's economy, which stands to lose around 3.7% of GDP by 2050.

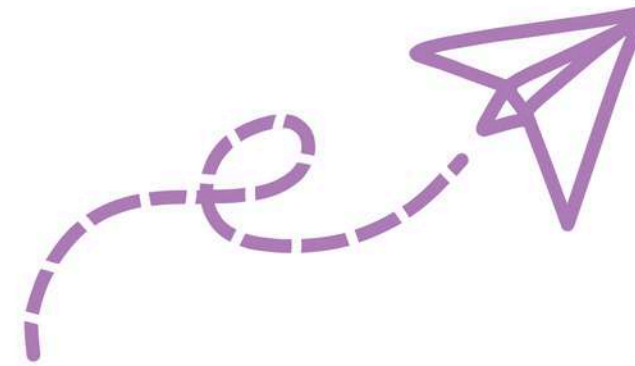


The highest noted temperature in Italy in 2023 was 45.5 °C

Climate change in Poland

Poland is vulnerable to the impacts of climate change such as increase in the frequency of extreme weather events including floods, droughts and hurricanes, sea level rise, increase in temperature and precipitation, which pose significant impact on Poland's agriculture, health, forestry, and biodiversity.

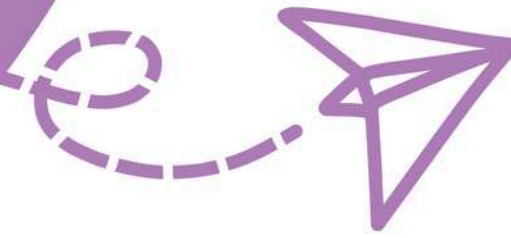
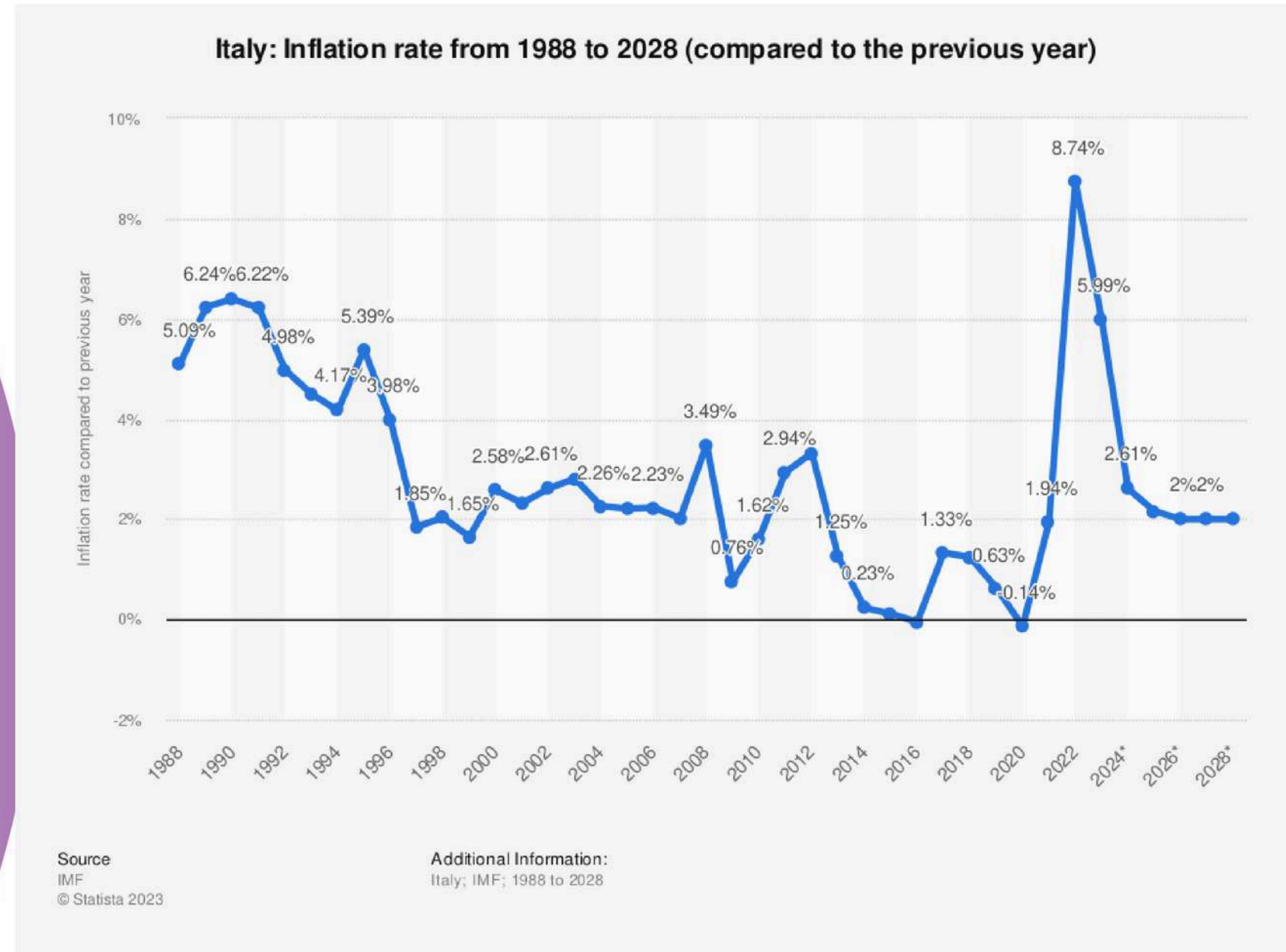
The highest noted temperature in Poland in 2023 was 37 °C



2. Inflation in Italy

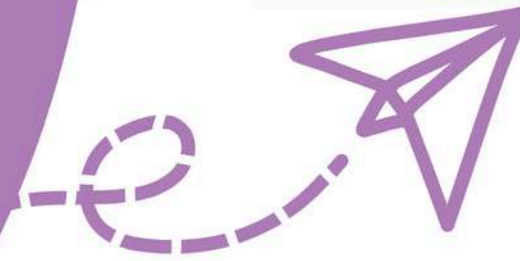
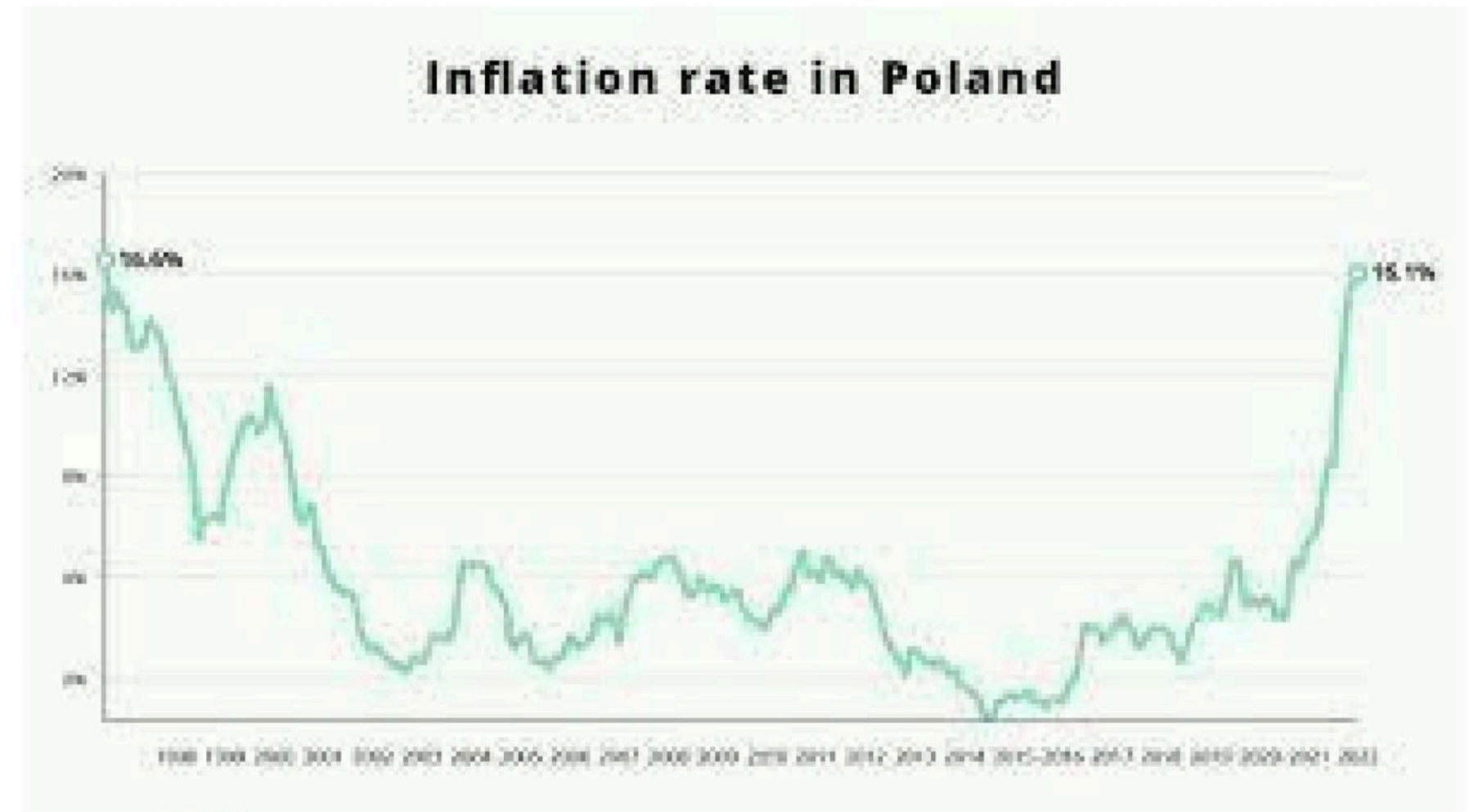
Inflation is the rate of increase in prices over a given period of time.

Italy Inflation rate is at 5.60%, compared to 5.50% last month and 9.40% last year. This is higher than the long term average of 2.16%.



Inflation in Poland

Poland's annual inflation rate eased for a seventh consecutive month to 8.2% in September 2023, the lowest since November 2021, from 10.1% in the previous month, according to preliminary estimates.

The Big Mac index is a survey created by The Economist magazine in 1986 to measure purchasing power parity (PPP) between nations, using the price of a McDonald's Big Mac as the benchmark.

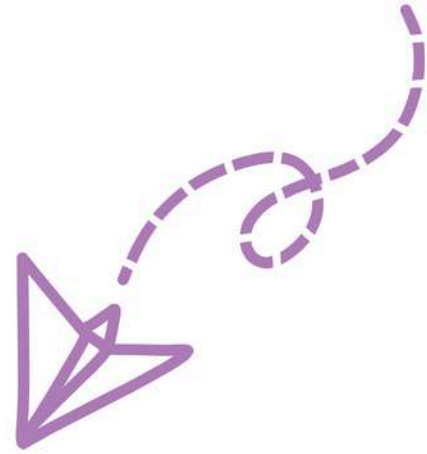

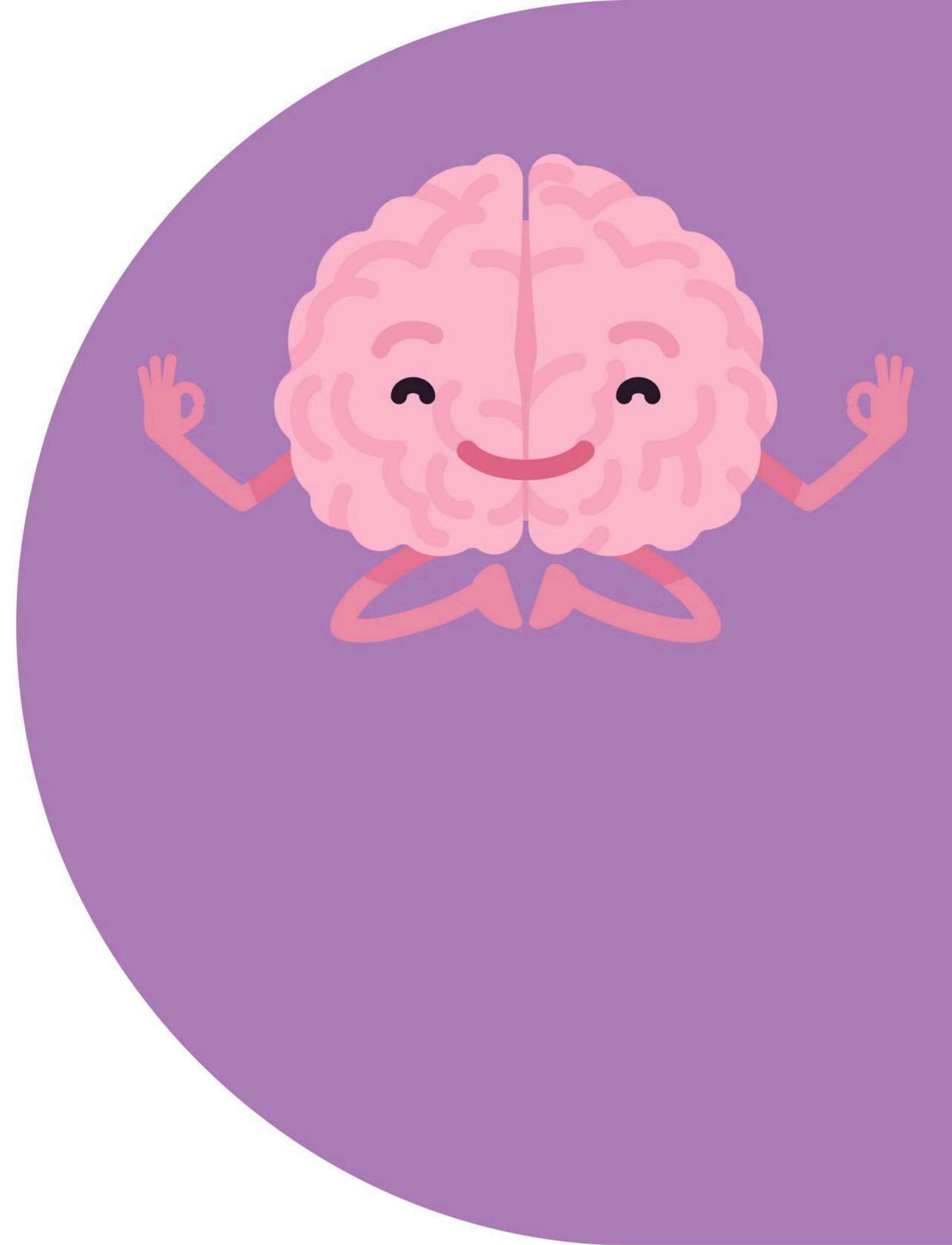

3. Mental health

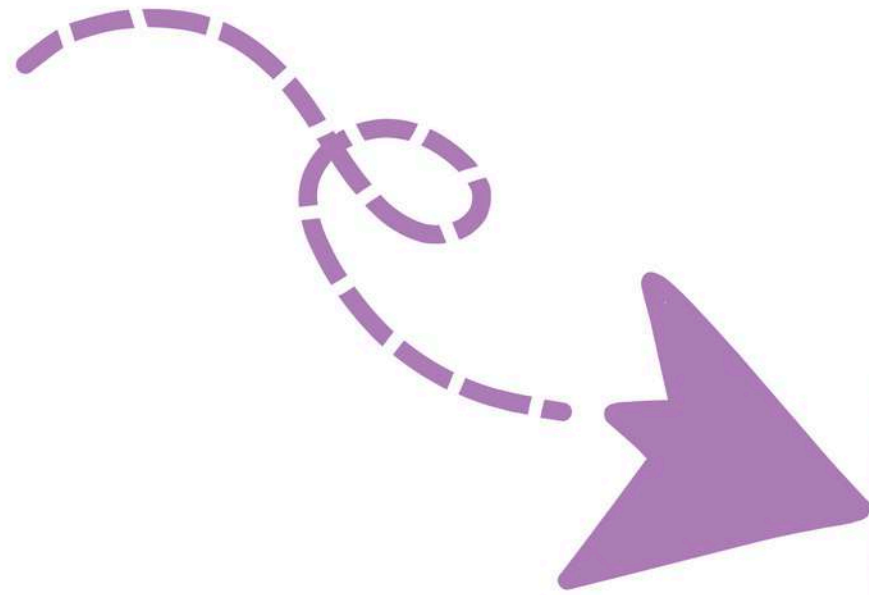


What is it?

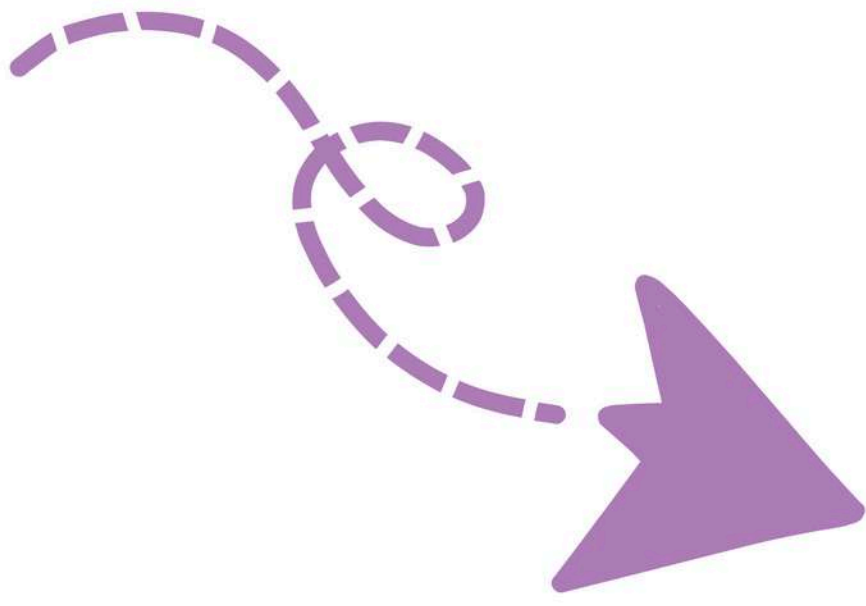

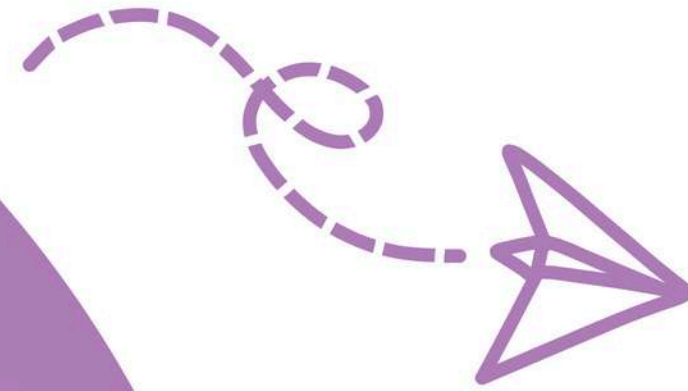

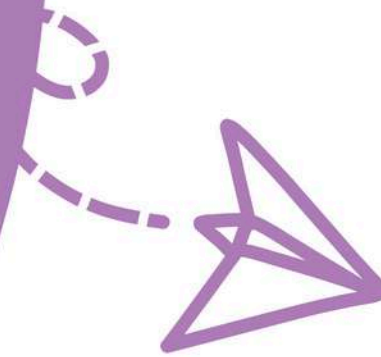
4. Migration
